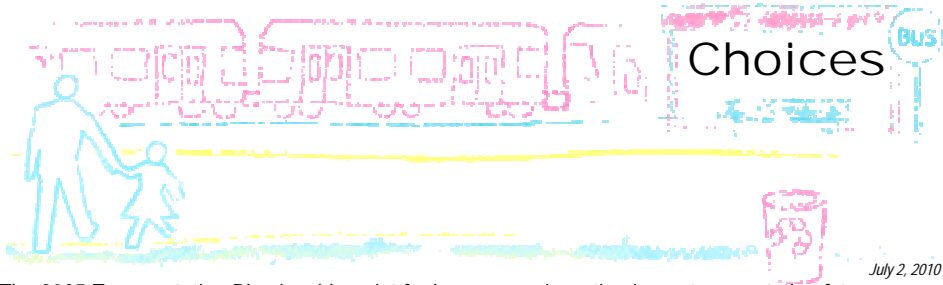


What's in the MPO's Transportation Plan for me?
